A unique pre-apprenticeship program providing young men and women, ages 12-17, the chance to build a career, earn a livable wage, and pursue economic self-sufficiency.

- Apprentices meet two Saturdays a month.
- Mentorship and education designed to foster goal-oriented character development in youth.
- Work closely with court services and families to assist in successfully transitioning from juvenile detention and probation.



BY THE NUMBERS

14 Active Pre-Apprentices
30 on the Waitlist
95% Program Retention Rate

Of our enrolled students, 85% are Black, and 15% are Latino, with 100% living below the poverty line.

The majority of our staff, volunteers, and board members are BIPOC, with 41% identifying as Hispanic, 16% as Black, and 8% as multiracial.
