

Templates for Reporting Mold and Water Issues to a Landlord or Property Manager

The following templates have been created by Alexandria Health Department with feedback from several local property managers to help residents file detailed reports of mold concerns in a rental property.

Please note – The use of these templates does **not** signify Alexandria Health Department's endorsement of complaints or concerns. These templates serve only as a starting point to help residents communicate information that is most useful for landlords and property managers to respond to complaints.

Reporting Mold

Use this template to first report your concerns of mold.

Dear Property Manager,

Use this template to verify which actions your landlord or property manager has taken in response to your mold complaints.
