Report of Jason North, Alexandria Police Department

Calls for Service (CFS)

- Over the past 30 days there were 85 instances where police responded to locations within the Waterfront. This is up from 71 in the last reporting period but down from 136 in November and 141 in October.
- The most common call types were
 - 911 hang ups (13)
 - Commercial alarms (8)
 - Disorderly (5)
- Most CFS occurred Monday (16), Tuesday (16), Wednesday (17), and Thursday (18).
- The fewest number of CFS occurred Friday (6), Saturday (7), and Sunday (5).

Incidents (CFS that require a Police Report)

- Of the 85 CFS noted above, 12 required a police report. This is down from 14 in the prior reporting period.
- There was little activity of note and no observable patterns suggesting emerging or repeat behavior.
- The only incident that *perhaps* may have some interest to this group was at the Waterfront Park on New Year's Eve, when a suspect known to the victim displayed a folded knife during an argument. The blade was not taken from the folded position, and the incident did not escalate further

Parking Complaints

- There were 17 reported parking complaints this month. This is down from 25 in the previous reporting period and 40 in the period before that.
