# Visiting Alexandria By Water

1. There is currently no way for the public to visit Alexandria by human powered boat (kayak, paddleboard, etc) anywhere other than Washington Sailing Marina. There are no also no other rental facilities.
2. There is no way for the public to visit Alexandria by power boat between the City Marina and Washington Sailing Marina. There is no dinghy access for large boats, and no piers for power boats.

- The only Kayak rental is at Washington Sailing
- Washington, DC has multiple rental sites




