



RESTAURANT OPERATING STANDARDS

Per City of Alexandria Zoning Ordinance Use Limitations Sections 7-1900 and 7-1904

TRAINING REQUIRED



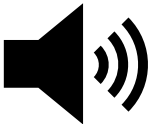
Ongoing employee training is required to advise staff of these operating standards (use limitations). Post this document in a visible location. Violations may result in citations.

NEIGHBORHOOD LIAISON



A neighborhood liaison must be designated and contact information including name, phone number, and email address provided to abutting properties. Information must be kept current at all times.

NO EXTERIOR SPEAKERS



All speakers are prohibited from the exterior of the building.

LIVE ENTERTAINMENT



Indoor live entertainment is only allowed indoors and pursuant to section 7-1903 of the Zoning Ordinance.

STORAGE OF CHEMICALS



Chemicals, detergents, and cleaners must be stored within an enclosure with roof.

NO OUTDOOR STORAGE



No food, beverages, or other materials are allowed to be stored outside.

DELIVERY VEHICLES



Delivery vehicles must park off-street when not delivering.

LOADING HOURS



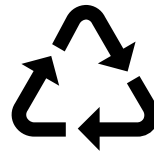
Deliveries of supplies are not allowed between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.

TRASH MANAGEMENT



Trash must be stored in sealed containers and must not accumulate outside of containers.

WASTE DISPOSAL



Waste must be disposed of in accordance with local, state, and federal laws and regulations.

NO OUTDOOR CLEANING



Kitchen equipment is not allowed to be cleaned outside.

USED COOKING OIL



Outside storage of used cooking oil must be secured and covered.

Any business that deviates from these use limitations requires Special Use Permit approval.
