Thank you for your response regarding the recommendations included in the Security and Threat Assessment conducted by Captain Al Tierney of the Alexandria Police Department.

I am pleased to know that Norfolk Southern has responded affirmatively to the Police Department's recommendations, but feel strongly that your response still falls short of providing the assurance City residents need to feel safe about your operation. Norfolk Southern has opted to pursue the "lesser solution" regarding a security presence. Nothing short of Captain Tierney's "optimum solution to security/safety at the facility" is acceptable for the residents of the City of Alexandria. Your facility requires a 24/7 human security presence.

As Mayor, on behalf of the residents of the City of Alexandria, I hereby demand implementation of the optimum solution specified in the Security and Threat Assessment.
