Route 1 Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Stations Concept Design (Potomac Avenue to East Glebe Road)

Public Meeting – **June 14, 2012**, 6:30-8:30pm, Cora Kelly Recreation Center

The City of Alexandria invites members of the public to attend the Route 1 Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Station Concept Design public meeting to discuss the design of the transitway stations. This meeting will focus on the vertical elements of the station design including the shelter, fare collection devices, next bus technology, benches, trash receptacles, etc. The meeting will give the public an opportunity to provide input into the location of items as well as the look and feel of the BRT Stations on Route 1 between Potomac Avenue and East Glebe Road.

Transit Stations will be located in the median areas at the following intersections:

- Route 1/East Glebe Road
- Route 1/East Swann Avenue
- Route 1/East Custis Avenue
- Route 1/Potomac Avenue

An update on the BRT transitway design and construction will also be provided including information on vehicular access to and from Route 1. Currently, the design-build project is at 90% design and slated to start construction in July, 2012, completing the transitway and stations in late 2013.
