



**WOODROW WILSON BRIDGE PROJECT  
U.S. Route 1 Interchange Contract**

**OVERNIGHT RESURFACING WORK ON ROUTE 1  
FROM I-95/I-495 TO FRANKLIN STREET  
MAY RESULT IN SOME NOISE AND VIBRATIONS**

To minimize traffic impacts and weather permitting, contractors are scheduled to resurface U.S. Route 1 between the I-95/I-495 interchange and the Franklin Street intersection from 5 p.m. to 7 a.m. daily from Sunday, Aug. 10 until Tuesday, Aug. 12.

During the work, traffic will be reduced to one lane northbound and southbound on U.S. Route 1 and may be halted intermittently to allow for traffic pattern shifts and trucks and other equipment to access the work area.

Residents should be aware that satisfactorily completing the work requires the use of vibrating rollers, trucks and other heavy equipment. The contractor will use every available measure to minimize noise, vibrations and other disturbances to area residents, but we wanted to notify you in advance about what to expect.

We regret any inconvenience this proposed nightly work might cause. We also thank you for your patience and understanding as we strive to complete all of the improvements to U.S. Route 1 and the rest of the Wilson Bridge Project corridor as quickly as possible.

Please use caution when traveling in this area. All construction-related road work is subject to change, depending on weather or other unforeseen conditions.
