**REGISTRATION:** By mail (using this form), on-line at [www.washingtonbirthday.net](http://www.washingtonbirthday.net), or at Packet Pickup locations only at the times listed below.

**PACKET PICKUP:** • Pacers, 1301 King Street, Alexandria (near King Street Metro) Thursday, February 14 from 5 to 7 p.m.; Friday, February 15 from 5 to 8 p.m.; • AMC Hoffman Center Theater, Saturday, February 16 from 6:30 to 8:15 a.m. (Race Day).

**COURSE:** There will be two courses: The 10K USATF Certified Course (a course map is available on the website) and, for those interested in a shorter run, there will be a 2K “Fun Run.” The 10K Race timing will be by Pacers, Inc. Results will be posted on [www.washingtonbirthday.net](http://www.washingtonbirthday.net) in the 10K Race section and sent by e-mail to all runners.

**RAISE DONATIONS AND RUN FOR FREE!!** Collect \$100 in donations and the registration fee will be waived. Donation checks must be mailed in with registration form.

**DIRECTIONS:** • From I-95/495: Take Telegraph Road north (Exit 2B). Turn right off the exit onto Pershing Avenue, right again on Stovall Street, then left on Eisenhower Avenue. Follow signs to on-site parking. • From Alexandria: Take Duke Street (Rte 236) toward I-95: turn south on Telegraph Road, stay in right lane. At the Hensley Park sign, exit right onto Mill Road, turn right again. In ¼ mile, turn right on Stovall Street, then left on Eisenhower Avenue. Follow signs to on-site parking. • Metro: Take Metro Yellow Line to Eisenhower Avenue.

**T-SHIRTS:** To be guaranteed a long-sleeved T-shirt, registration must be received by Friday, February 10th. Those registering after February 10, 2008 cannot be guaranteed a long-sleeved T-shirt.

**REFRESHMENTS:** After the race, near finish line.

**PRIZES:** Top three male & female finishers will each receive: \$250 (1st Place), \$150 (2nd Place), \$75 (3rd Place). Top two male & female finishers in the following age categories will each receive merchandise awards: 14 and under, 15-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70 and over.

**RESTRICTIONS:** No headphones, dogs, in-line skates, bicycles or roller-blades.

**PROPERTY STORAGE:** Available on race day.

**HAZARDOUS WEATHER:** While every effort will be made to hold the Race, it will be canceled if the weather is judged to be hazardous to the safety of the runners. In the event of cancellation for any reason, entry fees will not be refunded.

I recognize that running a road race is a potentially hazardous activity. I have read the race flyer and am familiar with the course, procedures, and rules. I should not enter and run unless I am medically able and properly trained. I agree to abide by any decision of race officials relative to my ability to safely complete the run. I assume all risks associated with running in this event including, but not limited to: falls, contact with other participants, the effects of the weather, including cold, snow and/or ice, high heat and/or humidity, traffic and the conditions of the road, all such risks being known and appreciated by me. Having read this waiver and knowing these facts and in consideration of your accepting my entry, I, for myself and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, waive and release the organizers of the George Washington Birthday Classic 10K, its directors, officers, staff, and volunteers, Alexandria Police Youth Camp, Inc., Pacers Running Stores, Pacers Events LLC, and Pacers Running Club and their respective volunteers, employees and/or contractors, Road Runners Club of America, the City of Alexandria, Virginia and its employees, and all sponsors, their representatives and successors from all claims or liabilities of any kind arising out of my participation in this event even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons named in this waiver. Further, I grant permission to all of the foregoing to use any photographs, motion pictures, recordings or any other record of this event for any legitimate purpose without notice or compensation and to release my race results including my full name, age, city and state, and race times to any entity the race organizer sees fit. I understand that headsets of any kind, in-line skates, or bicycles are prohibited. I hereby grant to the medical director(s) of the race, and his/her agents, affiliates and designees, access to all medical records (and physicians) as needed and authorize medical treatment as needed. I acknowledge that the entry fee is non-refundable and non-transferable. In the event the race is delayed or prevented by reason of fire, threatened or actual strike, labor difficulty, work stoppage, insurrection war, public disaster, flood, unavoidable casualty, acts of God or the elements (including without limitation, hurricanes, tornadoes, or earthquakes), or any other cause beyond the control of the race organizers there shall be no refund of the entry fee or any other costs of the athlete in connection with this event. The City of Alexandria complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act for qualified individuals. If reasonable accommodation is needed, please contact the Race Director ten days prior to an event.
