Dear Mr. Kendall:

This is to bring to your attention multiple citizen complaints the City of Alexandria has received relating to the CSX maintenance project to replace cross-ties and surface tracks between Alexandria and Woodbridge.

Previously, CSX has worked in partnership with the City in an effort to notify the affected public of planned projects. Unfortunately, public outreach has not been administered for this project, resulting in the public being caught unaware of the activity or duration of the noise impact. You may recall that in 2009, CSX conducted an outreach effort that included mailing post cards to residents, hosting a community meeting, notifying and coordinating with the City to send notices of the project activities via e-news lists, newsletters, and bulletin boards, and placed advertisement in local newspapers for its bridge replacement construction project. This outreach resulted in a smooth execution of the project in which the public was kept informed of the progress and the schedule, avoiding potential residential complaints.

The City requests that CSX immediately explore all options and conduct public outreach before a project is implemented. We recognize the safety aspects that may arise, but request that options be explored to do this work during day time hours in order to prevent noise issues at night. However, if nighttime work is absolutely essential, there may be specific guidance to the train operators not to use horns any more than absolutely necessary.

The City remains dedicated to working with CSX and expect reciprocity in this regard. Please contact me or William Skrabak at 703-746-4065 if you have any questions.
