



2. Project Purpose

- For Route 1 southbound, disconnect the right turn and through movements.
- Improve Pedestrian Access at the intersection.

- Right lane merges with through traffic causing backups along Route 1.

- Handicap ramps are non-compliant








5. What to Expect During Construction

- Regular Work Hours
7:00 AM to 6:00 PM (Mon-Fri)
- Estimated Construction Schedule:
Start Spring 2016; Finish by Fall 2016
- Some noise & disturbance

5. What to Expect During Construction


- Temporary Vehicular traffic control (24 hrs)
 - Route 1 southbound: 2 through / 1 left



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5. What to Expect During Construction


- Temporary Vehicular traffic control (Off-Peak)
 - Route 1 southbound: 1 through / 1 left



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5. What to Expect During Construction

- Pedestrian Detour
 - Initially, the sidewalk will be closed immediately adjacent to the project site. Pedestrians will be directed to ADA compliant crosswalks west and north of the site.



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5. What to Expect During Construction

- Pedestrian Detour
 - ADA compliant crosswalk west of the site.



5. What to Expect During Construction

- Pedestrian Detour

Then, pedestrians will be directed around the project, utilizing the newly built Jackson Crossing sidewalk.
