



On March 10 and 11, a team of City officials and staff participated in a policy institute in Richmond, which provided training on *Ready by 21* standards, such as: aligning and coordinating the work of all community stakeholders (including public, private and nonprofit agencies); agreeing on specific goals for all children and youth; and establishing measurable outcomes to gauge their progress. As noted in the previous memorandum, staff will also receive ongoing technical assistance to apply these strategies, including: technical assistance on gathering input from youth, families and stakeholders; aligning various databases among agencies to track conditions and outcomes for youth and families; developing a “big-picture action plan”; and using data to adopt effective policies and practices.

Several agencies currently provide services to a number of youth between the ages of 19 to 21. The attached chart shows the number of youth 18 to 21 served by department and agency in FY 2010, and the percent this population represents in the total number of persons they served. In several instances these child serving agencies are required by statute to provide services to this age group even though in other ways they may be considered adults. This includes youth in foster care, those with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs), and youth who have committed juvenile offenses prior to age 18 and are still on probation.
