WATERFRONT COMMENT BOARD SUMMARY

November 29 – December 6, 2011

- A posting that is a **re-print of the *Letter to the Editor of the PATCH* titled *City's Waterfront Plan Endangers National Historic Landmark*.**
- A posting stating there was information shared at the CAAWP event several weeks ago indicating there would be high rises on the waterfront. The author questioned the information since **the Plan indicates that buildings could be 5 stories, and not rise to high-rise levels.**
- A posting from a **CAAWP member indicating the proposed hotel on the Cumming site, could rise up to 7 stories.**
- A posting of a **press release from CAAWP** indicating former EPA head William K. Reilly is requesting revisions to the waterfront plan.
- A posting clarifying that the **City is NOT proposing high rise hotels. The posting also indicated that most buildings in the area are 5 stories and asked for clarification as to whether the proposed hotel on the Cumming site would be 7 stories.**
- A posting titled ***Alexandrians are Saved*.**
- A posting indicating it was uplifting to see people – mostly families – along the waterfront on Saturday watching the **Parade of Boats.**
