

# General Information

- All data are for females aged 10-19 years
- Age groups are:
  - <15 years
  - 15-17 years
  - 18-19 years
- Data include raw numbers and rates
- Rates are per 1,000 females

The Virginia Center for Health Statistics define total pregnancies as the sum of live births, induced terminations, and natural fetal deaths.

Total Pregnancies=

Live Births + Induced Terminations + Natural Fetal Deaths

# Overall Teenage Pregnancies: Alexandria 2008

- 223 resident teenage pregnancies:
  - 99 (44%) resulted in live births
  - 111 (50%) resulted in induced terminations
  - 13 (6%) resulted in natural fetal deaths

Total Teen Pregnancies (223) =

Live Births (99) + Abortions (111) + Fetal Deaths (13)




