

## Self Check up -Do It Yourself

It is easy to review the changes to your plan and make the changes yourself.

What you'll need

A computer

Your medication list with the names and dosages of your medications

Your Medicare card

1. Go to [www.medicare.gov](http://www.medicare.gov). Click on multimedia plan finder on the left to watch a video
2. Click on Personalized search and complete the required information. Click on find plans
3. Compare Plans
4. Check the plan's star rating and select plans that have at least a three star ratings
5. Compare the cost of plan premiums and deductibles

If you are satisfied with your current plan, no further action is needed.

If you compare plans and find a plan that better meets your needs.

1. Call the plan or check their web site to confirm the information from plan finder
2. Switch plans
3. Switch to the plan by calling to request the change or enrolling on their web site

Call 1-800-Medicare to request the switch to your selected plan

Enroll in the plan on the Medicare web site: [www.medicare.gov](http://www.medicare.gov)

Your coverage in the new plan will start January 1 and you will be disenrolled from the old plan.
