

**Alexandria Electoral Board
Minutes for June 3, 2020 Virtual meeting**

Chairman Brown called the June 3, 2020 virtual meeting to order at 1 p.m. Present were the three members of the Alexandria Electoral Board (Bruce A. Brown, Jack Powers and Mary Lyman), Anna Leider, General Registrar, Angie Maniglia Turner, Elections Manager and two members of the public (Holly Wallace & Sean Lenehan).

Electoral Board and Election Office Reports

Mr. Powers moved to approve the minutes from the May 14th meeting, Ms. Lyman seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Ms. Maniglia Turner provided the Board with additions and deletions to the list of appointed election officers. The Board reviewed the list. Ms. Lyman moved to approve the list, Mr. Powers seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Ms. Leider and Ms. Maniglia Turner reported on preparations for the June 23, 2020 Republican Primary Election. Discussion ensued about the expected turnout and methods to hold voting safely during the COVID19 pandemic. The Board agreed that each member should visit all the polling places on June 23, 2020.

Additionally, the Board discussed the possible situation in which voters are unable or unwilling to wear a mask inside the voting location. Those voters will be offered curbside voting. If they refuse and only in order to diffuse a situation, the election officers may offer a “hybrid curbside option”, in which the voters will be checked in outside, mark their ballot outside and then are accompanied by an election officer inside to scan their ballot. This situation shall be recorded in the incident report and the locations in which a voter might have touched shall be sanitized.




At 2:28 p.m., Mr. Powers moved to adjourn the Board Meeting. Ms. Lyman seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
