

Alexandria Electoral Board
Minutes for July 28, 2020 meeting

Chairman Brown called the July 28, 2020 meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Present were the three members of the Alexandria Electoral Board (Bruce A. Brown, Jack Powers, and Mary Lyman), Angela Maniglia Turner, General Registrar, Casey Leigh Clark, Assistant Elections Manager, Mayor Justin Wilson and 4 members of the public (Andrew Duke, Abdi Panth, Karl Bach and Pam Berg).

Electoral Board and Election Office Reports

Mayor Wilson presented former General Registrar Anna Leider with a proclamation from City Council, thanking her for her service. Chairman Brown announced the unanimous appointment of Ms. Maniglia Turner to the position as General Registrar. Additionally, he thanked Ms. Clark for her assistance with the administrative aspects of the hiring of the new General Registrar.

Mr. Powers moved to approve the minutes from the June 3, June 22, June 24, and June 26 meetings, Ms. Lyman seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Ms. Maniglia Turner presented the Board with additions and deletions to the list of appointed election officers. The Board reviewed the list. Ms. Lyman moved to approve the list, Mr. Powers seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Ms. Maniglia Turner reported on preparations for the November 3, 2020 General Election. Discussion ensued about the expected turnout and methods to hold voting safely during COVID19. Mr. Powers moved to approve the schedule for the November 3, 2020 General Election, Ms. Lyman seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Discussion ensued about vote by mail and the large increase in voters who are requesting absentee ballots by mail. Mr. Powers moved to approve the use of "MyBallot" for the emailing of absentee ballots for qualifying voters, Ms. Lyman seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The Electoral Board reviewed the status of polling places for the Presidential election, and Mr. Brown moved that the voting location for the Ladrey Senior building precinct be moved to the Charles Houston Rec Center and the voting location for the Hermitage precinct be moved to the John Adams School for the upcoming November 3 General Election. Additionally, he directed Ms. Maniglia Turner to move forward in discussions with polling places using the guidance provided, Ms. Lyman seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

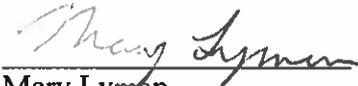
At 1:09 p.m., Mr. Powers moved to adjourn the Board Meeting. Ms. Lyman seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
