**A. PARTICIPANT DATA**

The Actuarial Valuation and Review considers the number and demographic characteristics of covered participants, including active participants, vested terminated participants, pensioners and beneficiaries.

This section presents a summary of significant statistical data on these participant groups.

**Active Participants**

Plan costs are affected by the age, years of credited service and salaries of active participants. In this year's valuation, there were 446 active participants with an average age of 39.9, average years of credited service of 11.5 years and average projected salary of \$74,578. The 458 active participants in the prior valuation had an average age of 39.6, average service of 11.3 years and average projected salary of \$73,113.

Among the active participants, the data had complete age and service information.


**Inactive Participants**

In this year's valuation, there were 19 participants with a vested right to a deferred or immediate vested benefit.


In addition, there were 17 participants entitled only to a return of their employee contributions (nine as of the prior valuation).


**Pensioners and Beneficiaries**

As of July 1, 2009, 150 pensioners and two beneficiaries were receiving total monthly benefits of \$517,977. For comparison, in the previous valuation, there were 129 pensioners and two beneficiaries receiving monthly benefits of \$416,368.


The pensioner total includes 69 who currently receive disability benefits, of whom 44 were formerly in the Disability Income Plan. (Those participants have a normal retirement age of 60, including 30 disableds under age 60 and 14 disableds age 60 or older as of July 1, 2009.)
