The "soul" of the film is Gordie Bailey, who lost his life in a hazing incident as a freshman. He and 26 other pledges were told to drink four bottles of whiskey and six bottles of wine as part of the fraternity's initiation ceremony. Gordie was left alone after passing out and found dead nine hours later near a couch where he had been left to "sleep it off." **His death was attributed to alcohol poisoning.
