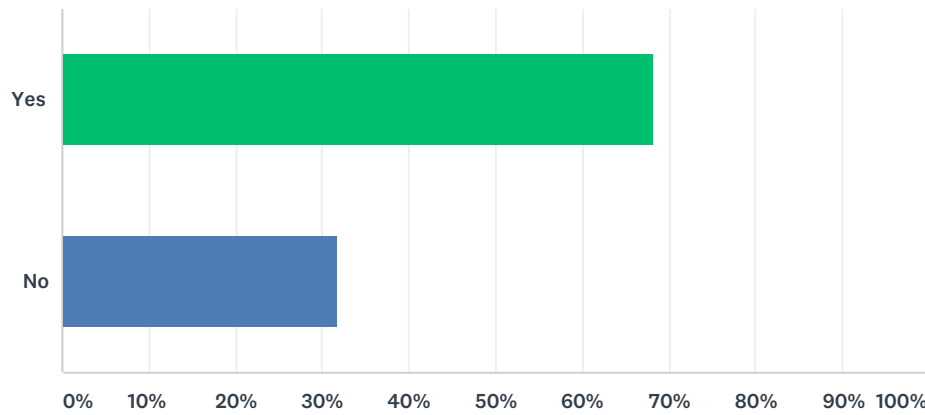


# Q1 Had you heard about Resolution 830 before being invited to participate in this process?

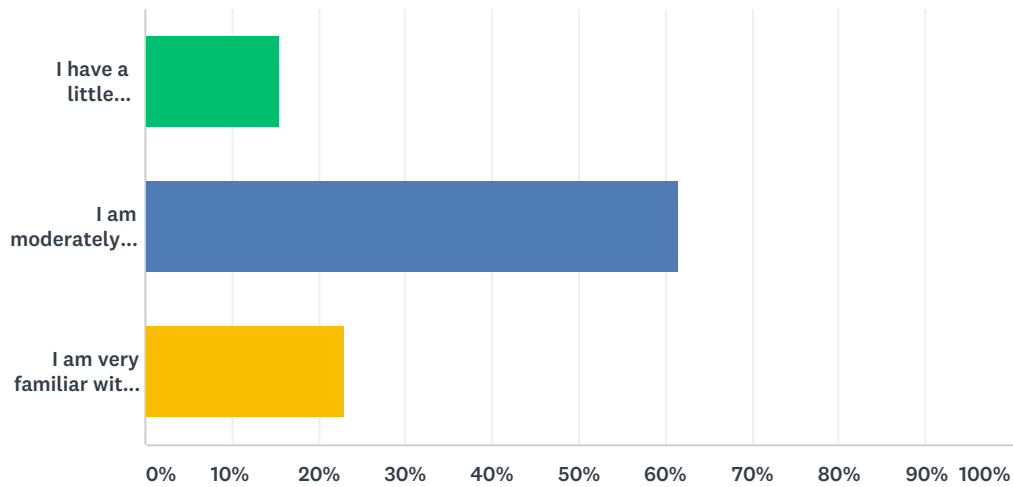

## Q2 How knowledgeable are you about Resolution 830 and its requirements?

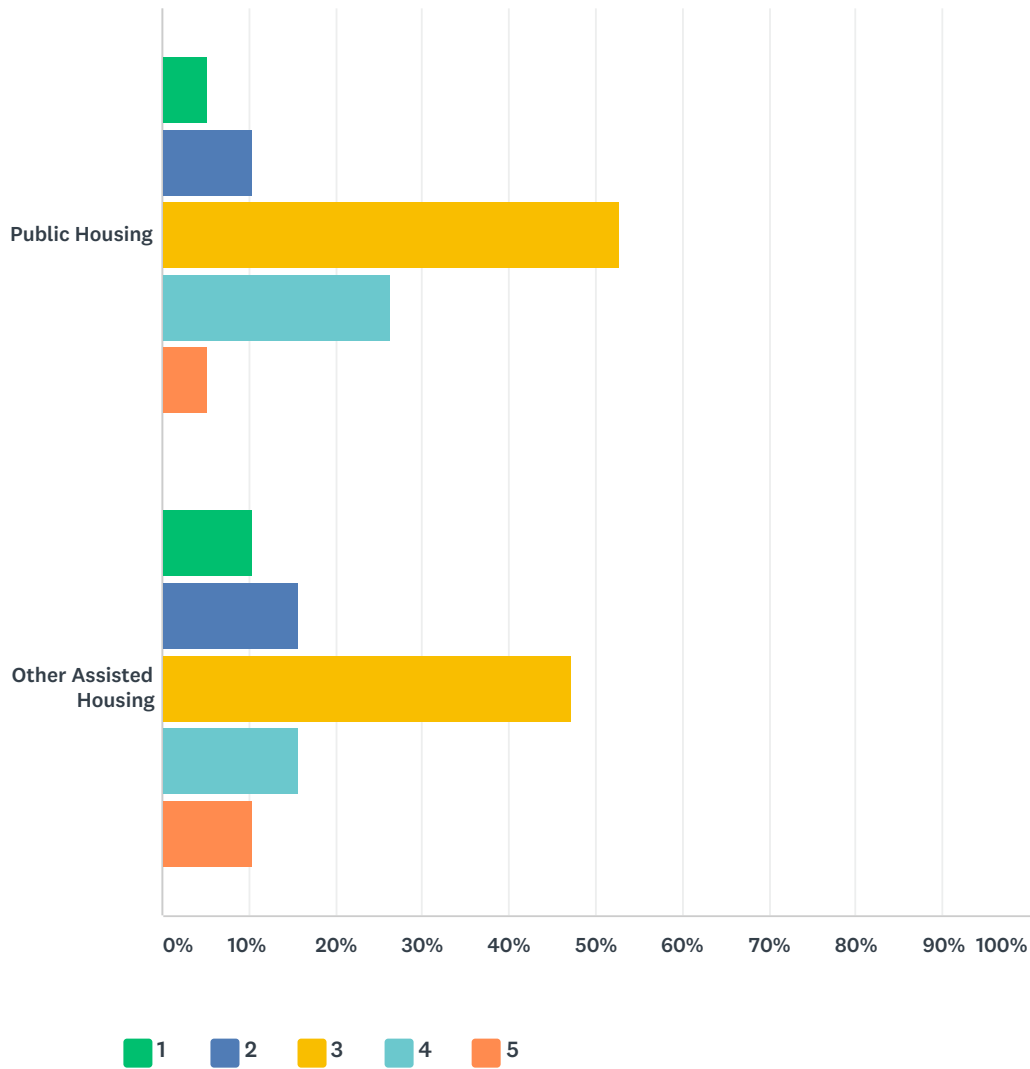

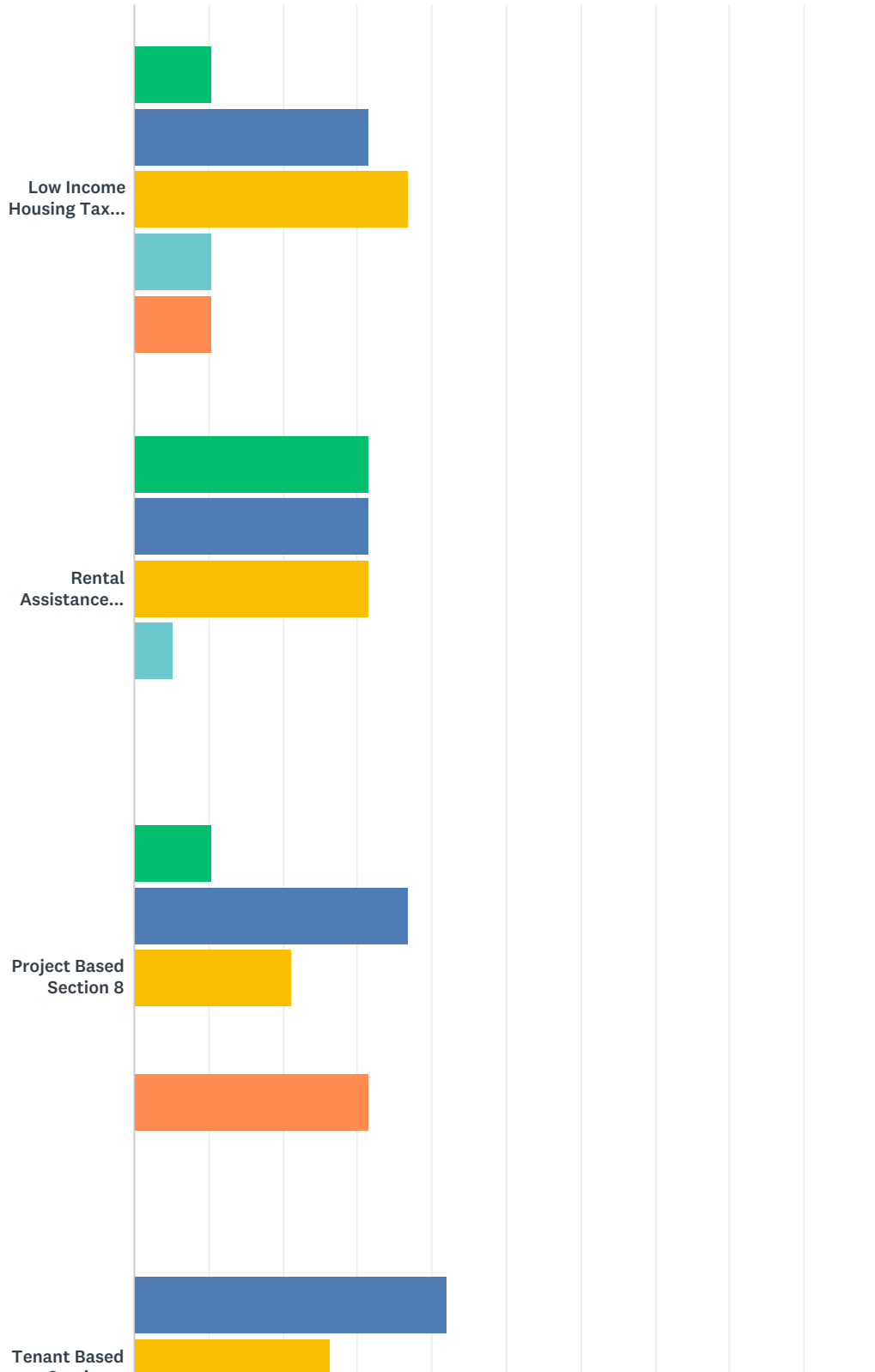

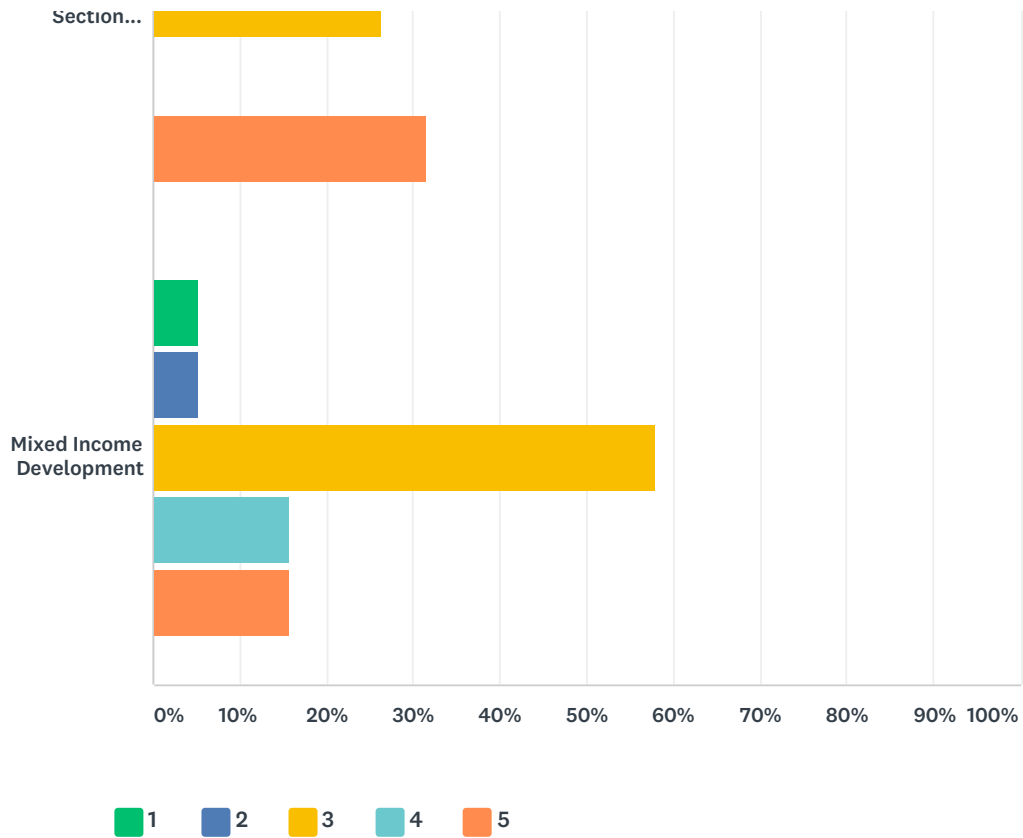
