

Clover-College Park Civic Association

A summary of the comments noted by Kimley-Horn and City of Alexandria staff during the Cambridge sidewalk public meeting on September 17, 2008:

- There was concern that narrowing roadway would make it more difficult for residents to turn out of their driveways.
- There was concern over having the sidewalk switch sides on Cambridge. This concern was addressed when it was explained that a crosswalk will be provided across Vassar.
- There was support for a new crosswalk since one resident observed children currently walk in their front yard.
- It was asked if the pedestrian demand warranted a new sidewalk and if a study has been performed.
- There was concern about children's safety crossing Cambridge at Janney's due to the high traffic volume. It was also noted that this is a crossing guard location.
- Residents wanted to know if a tree is lost during construction if the City will pay for the removal and replacement.
- There was some support for narrowing the street to reduce vehicle speeds.
- Some residents were unhappy with the idea of losing shrubs in their front yard.
- There were several questions asked about the 10 foot right-of-way behind the back of curb and how far the sidewalk will extend into their front yard.
- There were questions about the retaining wall appearance.
