## Metrorail

The Mark Center may be accessed via the Blue and Yellow Lines from the King Street, Van Dorn, Eisenhower Avenue, and Pentagon stations, and from the Orange Line's Ballston station. Metrorail fares will vary based on trip length. Transfer to bus routes listed below to access Mark Center Station or Southern Towers.

## Bus

Buses servicing Mark Center run to and from Mark Center Station and/or Southern Towers.

- DASH:** DoD employees and contractors boarding DASH buses at Mark Center Station or King Street Metro may ride free by showing the driver their valid [WHS BRAC 133-Mark Center ID/Common Access Card \(CAC\)](#), weekdays, from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. DASH also accepts SmarTrip and offers a monthly DASH Pass for unlimited rides throughout the month for \$35. [DoD employees and contractors should visit the WHS Transportation office to receive a DASH Pass.](#) The base fare is \$1.50 on all DASH Routes.
- WMATA:** DoD employees and contractors boarding WMATA Metrobus 7 Lines at the Pentagon, Mark Center Station, or Southern Towers may ride free with their [WHS BRAC-133 ID](#), Common Access Card (CAC). Regular bus fare = \$1.50 with SmarTrip card, \$1.70 without SmarTrip for Metrobus routes.

## VRE Trains

Two lines stop at Alexandria's Union Station adjacent to King Street Metrorail Station: Fredericksburg and Manassas. From the King Street Metrorail Station, take the DASH AT2 or AT2X Express to Mark Center or see Metrorail section above.

### Guaranteed Ride Home

This FREE program provides a ride home for registered commuters in the greater Washington/Baltimore metropolitan region who rideshare, bike, walk or take mass transit to work at least twice a week. In the event of an unexpected emergency or unscheduled overtime, Commuter Connections will arrange for a free taxi or rental car, whatever it takes to get you home, up to four times each year. ### Carpool

To find a carpool match, call Commuter Connections at 1.800.745.RIDE (7433). If you create a carpool of two or more people, please contact your DoD agency parking representative to register and secure a reserved carpool space. There is no parking in residential areas without a residential permit.

### Vanpool

To find a vanpool, call Commuter Connections at 1.800.745.RIDE (7433). If you create a vanpool of seven or more people, please have the vanpool administrator contact their DoD agency parking representative to register and secure a reserved carpool space.

### Bicycling

Holmes Run Trail, W&OD Trail, and Four Mile Run Trail provide regional access to the Mark Center. Bicycle parking racks are located in the North Parking Garage within feet of the pedestrian bridge. There are 44 showers

available on-site complete with lockers: 8 in the fitness center and 36 designated bicycle shower rooms on the lower level. Bicycle parking and shower privileges are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. For a free bike map with useful phone numbers and resources, stop by the on-site Local Motion booth, your local bike shop, the Old Town Transit Shop, City Hall, or any recreation center.

## Carshare
