The Complete Streets concept is a approach to creating streets that are safe for pedestrians, cyclists and drivers that has been embraced by cities all over the USA. Complete Streets sets a "goal of safety serving people whether they are driving, riding a bus, or using a bicycle or their feet. It clarifies that roads must be safe for a variety of people, including older adults, children on their way to school and people with disabilities." ¹
