GENERAL OBSERVATIONS		
1. Throughout: litter along Mt. Vernon Ave and on property line	TES, Operations/PWS	PWS cleans streets 6 days/wk – will start to include litter accumulating on property lines
2. Throughout: abandoned bikes/bike parts chained to City bike stands	APD/TES	TES agreed to remove abandoned bicycles if APD could tag them providing 72 hrs. notice to owner; APD cannot commit resources to this task at this time. Maintenance Code Div. has no authority to tag bicycles. PZ is working to find another alternative.
3. Throughout: grass/weeds growing through brick pavers (sidewalk)	RPCA, Park Operations	RPCA will follow up with weed abatement program where possible. RPCA has a small program to manage grass/weed growing between curbs/concrete in high visibility medians as well as weed abatement on sidewalks on some public properties. TES indicated there is no program within the dept to address issue.
4. Throughout: street trees/wells need upkeep		City ordinance requires adjoining property owners to abate weeds/vegetation in tree wells. TES and RPCA indicated there is no program within either dept to address issue. Property owners are contacted only if the City receives a complaint. PZ will work to distribute ordinance information to Arlandria property owners.
5. Safeway/Datatel site - Fencing surrounding sign and utility boxes at parking lot entrance (property owner wants to address); - Clothing donation boxes in parking lot (property owner wants to address overflow)	TES, PWS/CODE/PZ	PZ/Permit Center working with property owner to determine what is allowed Code will continue to monitor clothing donation boxes and connect with property owner as needed
6. Bus Shelter on MV Ave @ Reed in need of repair	TES	Existing shelter installed in 2012 – during that time glass panels have been broken/vandalized over 30 times despite notification signs in Eng/Esp – due to vandalism and cost, TES will no longer replace the panels at this particular shelter.
7. Flyering on utility boxes, esp. MV Ave and Russell	PZ	PZ will monitor and remove as necessary
8. Bulk waste - Business corridor / Multi-family dwellings	CODE	Code will monitor bulk waste disposal areas in business corridor as well as multi-family dwellings
9. Bike share stations - Possible to include bilingual signage re: reduced fees/\$2 rides etc?	TES, Complete Streets	Bilingual language cannot be included. All marketing materials are universal/standard for all of the city's stations. Complete Streets Manager is working with Casa Chirilagua on this issue and to make sure that information is communicated within the community concerning \$5 membership for low-income residents.

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10. Commuter bikers on trails – speed is an issue	RPCA/TES	Park staff are not trained or deputized to enforce ‘speed limits’. City could possibly begin an education campaign and install signs ‘Welcome to Alexandria’ and include some ‘decency rules’ like ‘slow down for the safety of others’.
11. Pedestrian lighting on Mt. Vernon Ave bridge over Four Mile Run – lighting often not functioning; Arlington responsibility	TES	TES is following up with Arlington County to address issue
