Dear Mr. Josephson and Mr. Sharma:

This letter is written in response to your letter dated November 11, 2008 in which you raised three issues that Virginia Paving Co. needs to address within 30 days of your letter. We at Virginia Paving have worked hard to establish a good working relationship with both the City and the Community, thanks in no small part to the cooperative efforts of the Virginia Paving Liaison Committee. While not conceding that the level of detail provided below are specifically required by the conditions of our Special Use Permit, they are helpful in maintaining the good working relationships we have established and are committed to accomplishing them. Listed below is how we will be addressing the three issues you raised:

1. **Hotline:**

Due to your concern regarding responsiveness to the hotline, we will be establishing service for a new cell phone, the hotline number will remain the same, which is passed to the responsible person on call for that time. If not answered in the first several rings, for instance, if the person is somewhere on the plant property where he/she doesn't hear or feel the ringer, the call will then rollover to backup numbers that will ensure someone answers the call to the best extent possible.

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We have determined through the history of the complaints received in the two years since we received our new Special Use Permit that there are certain items that may contribute to most complaints and therefore we are implementing the attached checklist for collecting information as quickly and thoroughly as possible about potential reasons for a complaint. We believe this systematic approach will ensure fuller responsiveness on our part to the limited complaints raised in the last two years.


3. Operational and Maintenance Issues

Finally, we firmly believe that being proactive with regard to operational and maintenance issues are the best course, as you identified in your letter. In that vein, we will also be implementing the attached checklist at the start of every shift to determine if there is any potential for malfunction of our equipment and fix it before the problem occurs, not after a complaint is raised.

We believe that the above is responsive to the issues raised in your letter dated November 11, 2008. We appreciate the ability to continue to work with the City in this respect. While we concede that certain issues have been brought up in larger numbers in the past several weeks, we would point out that in the two years since our current Special Use Permit was issued in November of 2006, the number of complaints has been limited, some have been unfounded and several of the founded complaints pertain to the same incident. We continue to believe that working cooperatively with the City and the community is the only course for successfully moving forward.
