We appreciate the Virginia Department of Transportation, Potomac Crossing, LLC, and the National Park Service attending and participating in the Jones Point Park meeting last week at the Lee Center in Alexandria. We thought that the meeting gave you the opportunity to explain the issues from your point of view, and also provided the park neighbors with the opportunity to explain their concerns and wishes. While dialogue on controversial issues among parties with differing positions is not always easy, in the end it makes for a better product and result.


We understand, from calls John made to our staff, that a decision has been made by VDOT to add an addendum to the bid specifications which would require that the contractor sequence the project in such a way that some of each of the major elements of the park would be open during the construction period. In effect, if we understand this correctly, what was listed as under Phase I would be broken into two or more smaller pieces during the construction period. It is our understanding that you will be sharing this addendum language with our respective staffs as a draft before it is finalized. We appreciate this additional opportunity for comment.

Thank you again for your efforts to amend the construction bid specifications to allow for more of the park to be open for use during the construction period.
