




Patrick Henry Recreation Center
Existing Site Plan




Patrick Henry Elementary School and Recreation Center



Design Goals



- Create an identifiable, welcoming and safe Entrance
- Insure that the Gym and existing toilets are accessible to the School during the day
- Insure that the Recreation Center can be closed off from the School
- Insure that staff can easily monitor the facility
- Zone the Activities so that “Noisy / Active “ activities and “ Passive” activities are Grouped Together
- Phase the design so that an additional, larger Gym can be constructed in the future
- Minimize any impact on the play fields and playground
- Maintain access around the school and recreation center
- Design the facility so that construction will not impact School Operations


Proposed Option 1- Site Plan






Proposed Option 1 -Floor Plan




Proposed Option 2- Site Plan




