The City of Alexandria Waterfront Committee invites the public to participate in its annual Waterfront Walk scheduled for Tuesday, June 8 at 7:30 a.m. The walk will begin in Oronoco Bay Park, 100 Madison St., and continue south along the City's waterfront to The Strand.

This annual event provides Committee members the opportunity to assess operational conditions and issues along the Waterfront. In addition, this year's walk includes discussions by City staff from the departments of Recreation, Parks, and Cultural Activities and Planning and Zoning on the City's Draft Waterfront Concept Plan.

Established by City Council in 1989, the Alexandria Waterfront Committee's purpose is to study and deal with issues relating to private and commercial uses of the waterfront. The Committee is composed of 15 members who represent a particular neighborhood, community or City committee. The Waterfront Committee meets the third Tuesday of each month at 7:30 a.m. at the Lee Center, 1108 Jefferson St.
