At the Alexandria City Council's Jan. 12 meeting, its first of 2016, the Recreation, Parks, and Cultural Activities Department was recognized for its E-3 certification from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality. An E-3 ranking recognizes facilities with fully-implemented environmental management system, pollution prevention programs and demonstrated environmental performance.
