



Summer Out of School Time Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT ARE THE AGES OF CAMPERS?

Power-On: Ages 6-12 entering grades 1-6 in the upcoming school year

Power-Up: Ages 11-14 entering grades 6-10 in the upcoming school year

WHAT ARE THE HOURS OF CAMP?

Programmed hours are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Pick-up is required by 6 p.m. All sites are closed on July 4.

CAN CAMP HOURS BE EXTENDED?

Yes, optional Before Care is available 7-9 a.m. for an additional \$39 per week.

WHAT IS THE STAFF/CAMPER RATIO?

Grades K-1 (Ages 5-6) is 1:20

Grades 2-6 (Ages 7-12) is 1:25

DOES MY CAMPER NEED TO BRING LUNCH/SNACKS TO CAMP?

A healthy lunch and snack are provided daily to the participants attending the Power-On and Power-Up programs at qualified sites. All food meets the USDA recommended guidelines. A menu is available to all participants and posted at the Center for parents to see. Participants with food allergies must notify staff and may need to make arrangements to bring a meal on days when they cannot eat the meal provided. At no time will children be forced to eat a meal.
