

Waterfront Landscape and Flood Mitigation Design Project

The City has engaged [The Olin Studio](#) and [URS Corporation](#) to work on the Waterfront Landscape and Flood Mitigation Design Project. Their charge is to develop a 15-30% design for the Waterfront that is based on the illustrative concept in the approved [Waterfront Small Area Plan](#), with flood mitigation integrated within that design. The work will extend over a 12 month period from July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014. Additional phases of the design work are anticipated to be completed in the future.

The City has scheduled a [Waterfront Landscape and Flood Mitigation Design Community Meeting Series](#), which began in October 2013 in order to receive community input during this process; it is a four-part Community Meeting Series. Community Meeting #3 was held on February 6, 2014 and showed 2 Alternatives for the Core Area of the Waterfront. The Core Area extends from Duke Street to Queen Street.
