



## **Frequently Asked Questions** **WATERFRONT CONSTRUCTION**

### **What are Waterfront Construction Hours?**

Construction in the **Public Right-of-Way** is permitted during the following hours.

- **Monday:** Friday: 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- **Saturday:** 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Construction **Onsite** is permitted during the following hours:

- **Monday: Friday:** 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- **Saturday:** 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

### **What are the Waterfront Construction Haul Routes?**

Please see [Indigo Hotel Haul Map](#) for approved routes: The Haul Routes will be marked with appropriate signage.

**Outbound:** The trucks shall turn left on Union Street south to Gibbon Street west to Route 1.

**Inbound:** Trucks shall use Route 1 turn right to Franklin Street east to Union Street north to the site.

### **Can construction trucks remain Idle while waiting?**

Construction trucks cannot idle for more than ten minutes, queue on the Strand, or block the entrances to the Strand Parking Lot.

### **What to do about dirt, mud, or debris in the public right-of-way?**

Any dirt, mud or debris tracked or spilled in the public right of way is the responsibility of the contractor and must be cleaned immediately.

The City monitors fugitive dust through visual observation, regular inspection and required control measures on site as part of the permit conditions and not with monitoring equipment. The contractor is required to implement best-management-practices aimed at controlling the fugitive dust and ensure that these work as effectively as possible. Construction & Inspection Division continue to routinely monitor fugitive dust.
