

Haul Route Selection Criteria

- Assess
 - Surface material (cobble stone & brick are not suitable surface material for haul route)
 - Geometry of the street (narrow streets & tight radii are not suitable)
 - Route from site to City limits (would street result in a “zigzag” route)
 - Adjacent land uses (school, playground/yard)



Haul Route Selection Criteria

- If there are current maintenance projects under way (Virginia Save Program)
- If the street is a through street to Route 1
- The bus traffic, pedestrian volumes, & special events
- *Ultimate Goal: The most direct route into and out of the City resulting in the least amount of disruption to the community.*
