Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB)	Virginia Dept. of Transportation, Dept. of Rail & Public Transportation, Dept. of Aviation, Port of Virginia. Board sets transportation policy and funding priorities for Virginia.	18-Sep	16-Oct	Presentations were given at the September 16, 2013 CTB meeting on VRE and on Transit Performance Metrics which have been discussed by the Transit Service Delivery Advisory Committee (TSDAC)	None
Transportation Planning Board (TPB)	Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments. The regional planning body that serves as the federally designated Metropolitan Planning Organization.	18-Sep	16-Oct	At the September 18, 2013 meeting, TPB briefly reviewed comments received concerning the draft TPB Regional Transportation Priorities Plan (RTPP). Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NVTA)	Nine cities/counties in NoVa with a 16-member board. Charged with preparing and implementing a regional transportation plan.	26-Sep	24-Oct	NVTA had a board meeting on September 26, 2013, in which the Board was briefed on DRPT's SuperNova plan and VDOT's HB599 prioritization study. NVTA discussed how the HB599 study as well as court actions will affect a call for projects and the development of a NVTA Six Year Plan	None
Northern Virginia Transportation Commission (NVTC)	Manages and controls the functions, affairs, and property of the Northern Virginia Transportation District which is comprised of six member jurisdictions, including Alexandria. NVTC provides a policy forum for its region and allocates state, regional, and federal transit assistance.	5-Sep	3-Oct	At its September 6, 2013 meeting, the NVTC Board received comments regarding the TSDAC committee, and authorized the Board to send a letter to TSDAC expressing concerns about the method of allocating new operating revenues. NVTC discussed some preliminary findings produced by the auditor of public accounts regarding VRE.	None
Washington Metropolitan Transit Authority (WMATA) Board	Provides rail, bus and paratransit services regionally and determines agency policy and provides oversight for the funding, operation, and expansion of transit facilities.	12-Sep	24-Oct	At the September 12, 2013 WMATA Board meeting, no action items were considered. The WMATA Planning, Program Development, and Real Estate Committee approved an item to grant the City of Alexandria a permanent easement which will enable it to construct a set of access improvements at the King St-Old Town Metrorail station.
