**Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
FY 2015 – FY 2024 Sources & Uses**

In FY 2012, City Council approved funding equal to 2.2 cents on the base real estate tax rate and additional General Fund cash capital to create a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the purpose of expanding transportation infrastructure and transit options throughout the City. **As part of the FY 2015 – 2024, as the City has realized new revenue from NVTA 70% and 30% sources, the definition of the TIP is proposed to be expanded for any transportation related expenditure.** Expanding this definition has allowed the City to direct TIP resources toward the maintenance of its existing transportation infrastructure while using the new NVTA funding, private development contributions, and the continued use of TIP proceeds to advance expanded transportation and transit infrastructure and services throughout the City. The TIP funds capital improvements, operating costs, and debt service on General Obligation Bonds issued before FY 2014. Details of the fund revenues, operating expenditures and capital projects are included below.
