


## Alexandria Transit Vision Plan – PARKFAIRFAX/NORTH RIDGE

The Parkfairfax and North Ridge communities are generally located in northern Alexandria between Quaker Lane and Russell Road. They are currently served by three Metrobus routes (10B, 22C, 23B), and four DASH routes (AT-3, AT-4, AT-3/4, AT-9).

For Parkfairfax & North Ridge, the key changes for the **2030** Recommended ATV Network include:

- DASH AT-3 & AT-4 maintain direct peak service to Pentagon.** The AT-3 and AT-4 routes – shown as “N23” and “N24” in maps – would maintain current routes and service levels from Braddock Road Metro to Pentagon, but would no longer extend into Old Town or Hunting Point. A transfer at the Braddock Road Metro would now be required.
- AT-9 redesigned as the “N8”.** The existing AT-9 would be redesigned as the new “N8” route on Martha Custis, north of Gunston, with all-day, frequent service from Parkfairfax and North Ridge to the new Potomac Yard Metro, Shirlington, Mark Center, the West End and Van Dorn Metro. Route would operate every 15 minutes or better, seven days per week, providing significant improvements in transit access for nearby residents in Parkfairfax and North Ridge.
- Elimination of Midday/Evening/Weekend Service on AT-3/4 Loop Route.** The existing AT3/4 Loop route would be discontinued due to low ridership with its resources reallocated to make other routes more useful for larger numbers of people. Affected riders may be able to use other nearby routes such as the new “N8”, or Metrobus 22A or 23B.
- Changes to 22A/22C Route.** The 2030 network maintains the existing Metrobus 22A route from Ballston to Shirlington, but extends it to the King Street Metro via Parkfairfax and North Ridge for improved regional connectivity. Due to this realignment, direct midday travel to the Pentagon from Parkfairfax that is currently possible via the 22A would now require a transfer at Shirlington to the new “N9” (West End Transitway).




### What can I access via transit in 30 minutes from Gunston Rd. & Valley Dr. at 12pm in 2030?

For Parkfairfax & North Ridge, the key changes for the **2022** Recommended ATV Network include:

- **DASH AT-3 & AT-4 maintain direct peak service to Pentagon.** The AT-3 and AT-4 routes – shown as “N23” and “N24” in maps – would maintain current routes and service levels from Braddock Road Metro to Pentagon, but would no longer extend into Old Town or Hunting Point. A transfer at the Braddock Road Metro would now be required.



- **AT-9 replaced by the “N10/N11”.** The existing AT-9 would be replaced by the new “N10/N11” routes, north of Gunston, with all-day, frequent service from Parkfairfax and North Ridge to the new Potomac Yard Metro, Shirlington, Bradlee Shopping Center and Mark Center. Routes would operate every 15 minutes or better, seven days per week, providing significant improvements in transit access for nearby residents.

- **Elimination of Midday/Evening/Weekend Service on AT-3/4 Loop Route.** The existing AT3/4 Loop route would be discontinued due to low ridership with its resources reallocated to make other routes more useful for larger numbers of people. Affected riders may be able to use other nearby routes such as the new “N8”, or Metrobus 22A or 23B.
