- **Final TMP submitted by Army**

- **BRAC-133 Advisory Group Meeting on September 15; next meeting on October 20**

NCPC Action

- **Approved on 9/2; vote was 8-3**
- **Approval with Recommendations:**
 - **DoD use traffic control officers at key intersections**
 - **DoD explore integration with the City's TDM Program (LocalMotion) to reduce SOV trips**
- **Develop a process for future updates to the TMP**

Ongoing TMP ISSUES

- **Enhanced transit versus shuttles**
 - **DASH and WMATA presented conceptual proposals to DoD/WHS**
 - **Shuttle Route Travel Time Runs underway**
 - **Potential DoD legal issues with procurement are being researched**
- **Traffic control officers at key intersections (GRIP)**
- **City/DoD agreement re: TMP**

BRAC-133 Conceptual Design

- **Agreement reached with FHWA and VDOT on scope of short-term/mid-term study and long-term study**
- **Concept Designs underway**
- **Consultant to report to the BRAC Advisory Group on short-term/mid-term options on 10/20**

Residential Permit Parking

- **Staff met with association representatives August 18 re: parking district program and potential code changes.**
- **Staff met with association representatives September 23 re: parking district boundaries**

BRAC-133 Open Space

- 2.425 acres of open space lost due to development footprint
- DoD has agreed to mitigation payment concept
- Dollar amount to be determined
- BRAC-133 Advisory Group members have expressed interest in the funds being used to acquire open space in the West End
