

BRAC-133 News Bulletin: September 1, 2011

Traffic Management: Beginning Tuesday, September 6, Alexandria Police will implement a traffic management plan at key intersections near BRAC-133. During the morning and afternoon rush hours, police employees and sheriff's deputies will be located at several intersections to keep traffic moving and prevent vehicle backups within intersections.

Parking District: A new daytime restricted parking district has been established for BRAC-affected neighborhoods. Signage for approved blocks has been installed, and parking restrictions will be enforced on blocks where signage is posted beginning Tuesday, September 6.

Meeting Reminder: The BRAC-133 Advisory Group will host a special meeting on Wednesday, September 7. The sole purpose of this meeting is to offer information regarding the Environmental Assessment (EA) process currently underway for the proposed HOV/Transit Ramp at I-395 and Seminary Road. The meeting will be held from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. at Landmark Mall, (5801 Duke St.) in the West End Community Redevelopment Room on the second level of the Mall. The room is located next to the Sprint Kiosk. Access to this meeting room is best gained by parking on the second level of the parking deck and entering through the Macy's Court Entrance.
