Dear Sir or Madam:

The City of Alexandria Department of Transportation and Environmental Services (T&ES) is planning to repave King Street, from The Strand to the King Street Metro. Resurfacing activities are scheduled to begin on Sunday, June 5, 2011.

Milling and paving activities will occur during the hours of 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday and construction is expected to last two to three weeks. While it is our intent to complete the work as quickly as possible, weather or equipment problems may cause delays, in which case the project will be completed as soon as possible thereafter. Please be aware of the following during this project:

1. Parking will be maintained on one side of the street at all times during construction operations. However, some parking impacts will be unavoidable. Temporary No Parking signs will be posted on each block prior to any construction activity; please respect these signs to allow our crews to complete this project as quickly as possible.
2. Traffic in the immediate area will be re-directed during paving operations. To facilitate traffic control, the City will post signs on side streets and use message boards, flaggers, barricades, and signs on King Street. Detours will be established from King Street to Prince (eastbound) and Cameron (westbound). Please observe traffic detours and signs.
3. Construction crews have been instructed to minimize impact to overhanging tree branches. Our City Arborist will be monitoring the situation throughout the project.
4. City T&ES staff will be on the scene for the duration of the project.
5. Streets will be re-striped as soon as practical following resurfacing.
