



ALEXANDRIA SPRING CLEAN UP

ALEXANDRIA SPRING CLEAN UP 2011

Participation and Preparation Guide

Spring Clean Up is available to City curbside solid waste and refuse customers. All businesses and residential customers who receive private refuse collection will not receive Spring Clean Up services.

THINGS TO KNOW:

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS: City residential curbside solid waste customers.

- **Place** materials at the curb (no alley pick up) before 7 a.m. on your assigned collection day.
- **Separate** items into four piles:
 - » Reusable items (tables, chairs, household furniture, or any other reusable items)
 - » Metal items (pots and pans, toasters, wire hangers)
 - » Electronics (stereos, computers, televisions); remember to clear the hard drive of all computers
 - » Refuse
- **Remember** that for employee safety and ease of collection please correctly prepare (or remove) sharp items, and tie brush in bundles no more than 4 feet long. Bundles should not weigh more than 75 pounds.
- **Unacceptable items** include concrete, hazardous waste, unbundled brush, loose yard waste, and building materials.
