




What is the AMP?

- Policy-oriented strategic update to the 2008 Transportation Master Plan
- Policies and Strategies that will guide transportation decisions for next 5 to 10 years
- Public-driven process

Process



Key Plan Elements



Balance the mobility needs of all users by incorporating the policy and *Complete Street Design Guidelines* and applying street typologies to the city's roadways to guide future street usage and function



Identify strategies that make it easier to use sustainable modes of transportation – including new mobility options – to **reduce congestion and greenhouse gas emissions** in support of the *Environmental Action Plan 2040* goals



Understand how **new technology** can improve mobility and safety in line with City goals



Determine priorities to increase transit ridership via completion of the three transitway corridors, integrating *Alexandria Transit Vision* recommendations, and other means to better serve existing and new riders



Develop a curbside management policy that **considers competing demands for limited city curbspace** – like parking, loading, and movement
