3. STAFF REPORTS AND UPDATES:

PUBLIC HEARING:

4. **ISSUE:** Consideration of a request to install “NO PARKING HERE TO CORNER” sign from the driveway in front of 5319 Fillmore Avenue to Seminary Road.

BOARD ACTION: Mr. Jonathan Johnson, Mrs. Cathering Johnson, and Mr. Taira Hibi spoke in favor of the request. Ms. Slack made a motion to approve Staff recommendation, seconded by Mr. Posey. The Board voted unanimously to approve the request.

5. **ISSUE:** Consideration of a request to install 15 MPH School Speed Limit signs with Flashing Beacons in the 400 block and 500 block of Cameron Station Boulevard at Samuel Tucker Elementary School.

BOARD ACTION: Mr. Yon Lambert, Pedestrian/Bicycle Coordinator, Transit Services Division gave a presentation on the Flashing Beacons. Mr. Cota made a motion, seconded by Mr. Posey to approve staff recommendation and recommend to the City Council to approve the recommendation. The Board voted unanimously to approve motion.

6. **ISSUE:** Consideration of a request to change the hours and days of operation for the metered parking in Carlyle (Zone 3) from 8 :00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday, to 8:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. Monday through Saturday.

BOARD ACTION: Mr. Ron Le Comte, Mr. Greg M. Stone, President Carlyle Home Owner Association, Mr. Michael Booth, Mr. Sami Marina, Justin Holmes, and Mr. Lee Hernlt spoke against the request. Mr. Norwood made motion to deny the request, seconded by Mr. Ruggiero. The Board voted 4 to 2 to deny the request. Ms. Slack, Mr. Cota voted against the motion. Mr. Johnson, Mr. Ruggiero, Mr. Posey, Mr. Norwood voted for the motion to deny.

- 7: **ISSUE:** Consideration of a request to install “NO PARKING 8:00 A.M. TO 1:00 P.M. SUNDAY ONLY” signs in front of 700 West Braddock Road at First Assembly of God Church.

BOARD ACTION: Pastor Wes Johnson of First Assembly of God Church Spoke in favor of the request. Mr. Norwood made a motion, seconded by Mr. Cota to approve the request. The Board voted unanimously to approve the request.
