


# Agency Roles

- **National Park Service (NPS):** Cooperating agency
- **Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA):** Cooperating agency





# Visual Resources

- No-Build
  - Potomac Yard development will be seen from George Washington Memorial Parkway (GWMP)
- Build Alternatives
  - Station and future Potomac Yard development will be seen from some GWMP viewsheds but vegetation will partially screen station

# Scenic Easement and Fee Simple NPS Land

- Greens Scenic Easement
  - Impacts under Alternative B only
- Fee Simple NPS Land
  - Impacts under Alternative B (as currently designed) and Alternative D




# Parks



- Potomac Yard Park
  - City-owned park
  - Impacts under Alternatives A and B due to pedestrian bridge touchdowns
  - Touchdowns would need to be coordinated with park design
  - Impacts under Alternative D due to tracks and facilities






# Cultural Resources

## George Washington Memorial Parkway

- Known by 2 names within study area:
  - Mount Vernon Memorial Parkway
  - Parkways of the National Capital Region
  - Identified as cultural resources
  - Section 106 analysis underway

# Local Plans



- CDD 10 – Potomac Yard/Potomac Greens Small Area Plan
- CDD 19 – North Potomac Yard Small Area Plan
- City of Alexandria Master Plan
  - Alternative B is consistent with local plans
  - No-Build, Alternative A and Alternative D are not consistent with Local Plans

# Noise &Vibration

- No-Build and Build Alternatives:
  - Noise & vibration affects residences close to Potomac Greens Park
- Alternatives A and D:
  - Additional impacts to proximate residences due to the location of track/station

# Waters of the U.S. (Wetlands)


- No Build and Alternative A:

- No impacts


- Alternatives B and D:

- Impact to wetlands


**Wetlands**

# Construction Access and Staging



- Construction traffic on City roadways for all Build Alternatives
- Alternatives A and B could be constructed without access from the Parkway
- Some construction work outside of normal work hours and single tracking
- Vegetation will be removed for construction
  - To be replaced after construction
- Will result in temporary impacts related to noise, vibration, water resources, parkland, air quality, visual quality
