Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NVTA)	Nine cities/counties in NoVa with a 16-member board. Northern Virginia Transportation Commission (NVTC)	Manages and controls the functions, affairs, and property of the Northern Virginia Transportation District which is comprised of six member jurisdictions, including Alexandria. NVTC provides a policy forum for its region and allocates state, regional, and federal transit assistance.	1-Apr	6-May	During its meeting, the NVTC board reviewed monthly gas tax revenues. Alexandria was one jurisdiction showing an unexpected increase in adjusted revenue, but this is likely caused by revenue attributed to the incorrect jurisdiction. In Alexandria, revenues range from approximately \$160,000 in Jan. 2009 to \$300,000 in Jan. 2010.	None
