Dear Alexandria Resident,

As you may be aware there are four residential streets in your neighborhood that have been identified for resurfacing and paving as part of the FY2015 Street Resurfacing Program. Those streets include Westview Terrace, Putnam Place, Hilltop Terrace, and Braxton Place. These streets were selected for resurfacing due to the failed condition and the deterioration of the existing asphalt. In advance of any resurfacing work the City does, we are required by federal law to conduct work on sidewalks, in order to eliminate trip hazards and ensure ADA compliance. Unfortunately because of the small size of these streets and the existing limited parking it is very tough to conduct this type of work without impacting the residents in the neighborhood.

There have been additional impacts and delays to this project due to weather conditions and unforeseen scheduling conflicts. On behalf of the City I would like to apologize for the inconvenience and ensure that we are doing everything we can to minimize the impacts to you moving forward. We are closely monitoring the progress and plan to only post no parking signs on days when work is being done. Staff was onsite yesterday and today making adjustments to the existing signage.

The updated work schedule includes the following:

- Friday, October 3 - Paving of Putnam Pl. & Milling of Braxton Pl. between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- Monday, October 5 - Paving of Westview Terr. & Braxton Pl. between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- Tuesday, October 6 - Paving of Westview Terr. & Hilltop Terr. between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.

This schedule is based on favorable weather conditions. The current forecast shows a chance of showers on Friday, which may cause delay. No parking signs will be posted to reflect the schedule above. Because of the required notification period for parking enforcement we typically include a window of dates in which to complete the work, however, as soon as the work is completed the signs will be removed. To mitigate the impact on parking staff has also worked with the George Washington Masonic Memorial to facilitate the use of their parking lot by residents impacted from this work.
