



1. How do you feel about the implementation of Proposal A on weekdays between 4 p.m. - 6 p.m. only?





2. How do you feel about the implementation of Proposal A at all times (24 hours per day, 7 days per week)?





3. How do you feel about the implementation of proposal B if the proposed restrictions applied to everyone—including residents?





4. How do you feel about proposal C?




