### **Presentation**

Ms. Sanders presented an update on status of the traffic study, timeline for data collection, and possible mitigation tools.

### **Group Discussion**

- Traffic calming tools (speed humps, curb extensions, raised intersections, etc.)
- Separate process for individual neighborhoods.
- Speed limit reduced from 25 mph to 15 mph on Fort William Parkway
- Roundabout installation
- Turn restriction to neighborhood street during PM peak hour
- Red light camera installation at Seminary Rd and St. Stephen Rd
- Speeding problem on Ft. Williams Parkway.

### **Group Suggestion**

- Use effective methods from other jurisdiction across the country.
- Provide locations for examples of mitigation tools installed in the City

- Provide second turn lane/widen the ramp to Telegraph road.
