TAXICAB RATES
EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2008

City of Alexandria Ordinance 4509, enacted on December 15, 2007, establishes the amount of fare to be charged as follows:

- (1) For the first one-sixth mile (initial meter charge).....\$2.75
(2) For each additional one-sixth mile or fraction thereof\$0.34
(3) For each 54 seconds of waiting time\$0.34
(4) For the second and each additional passenger 5 years of age or older\$1.25
(5) For each animal\$1.00
There will be no charge for guide or service animals assisting persons with disabilities.
(6) For each suitcase or similar piece of travel luggage over two pieces placed in the trunk, if handled by the driver\$0.50
(7) For three or more suitcases or similar pieces of travel luggage carried by the driver to the door of a single-family residence or the main entrance of any other building.....\$1.00
(8) For each trunk, footlocker, duffel bag or other bulky or heavy item, if handled by the driver.\$2.00
There will be no charge for wheelchairs, walkers, crutches or other assistive devices used by persons with disabilities.
(9) For three or more grocery and/or shopping bags, if handled by the driver in the vicinity of the trunk\$1.00
For three or more grocery and/or shopping bags carried by the driver to the door of a single-family residence or the main entrance of any other building\$1.00
Maximum charge for all grocery and/or shopping bags\$2.00
(10) Airport Surcharge - When an airport surcharge is paid by the driver, that surcharge may be added to the fare for the trip.
(11) Snow Surcharge - When authorized by the city manager and posted in the taxicab, a snow surcharge may be added to the fare for each trip\$5.00
(12) Fuel Surcharge - When authorized by the city manager and posted in the taxicab, a fuel surcharge may be added to the fare for each trip to cover an increase in the cost of gasoline.
