

# Evaluation of Alternatives


The **objectives** of the West End Transitway are to:

- Provide a direct, reliable, higher-speed, higher-capacity transit service
- Connect with the existing and future regional transit network
- Curtail growth in traffic congestion
- Respond to proposed development projects
- Serve as a catalyst for continued economic development
- Lead to a cost effective project
- Avoid or minimize negative impacts to the community and environment

Median Dedicated Transit-US 1 Metroway


The **West End Transitway Project**

will improve mobility through the Van Dorn/Beauregard corridor by providing a fast and high-capacity transit line between the Van Dorn Metrorail station and transit centers at Landmark Mall, Mark Center, Shirlington and Pentagon.

The Alternatives Analysis portion of the study evaluates different solutions to identify one alternative to be recommended for implementation.

An Environmental Assessment will comprehensively assess potential socio-economic, environmental and transportation effects of the proposed improvements.

The study is concurrently advancing concept engineering to refine project cost estimates and funding plans.



# Study Alternatives

The West End Transitway Project will evaluate the following transit improvement options:

# Build Alternative

Within the City of Alexandria, the **Build Alternative** for the West End Transitway would include dedicated transit lanes along significant portions of corridor, transit in mixed traffic, and transit in I-395 HOV lanes.
