ORDINANCES GOVERNING MOTORCOACHES**

ARTICLE VI. STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING*

Sec. 11-192. Two-hour parking limit for certain vehicles.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle, other than a private passenger automobile, bus, delivery sedan, van or pickup truck, three-fourths of a ton or under, upon any street or avenue in the city for a longer period of time than two hours, except in front or to the side of a building used as a place of business by the owner of such vehicle; provided, however, that where a lesser parking period is prescribed and designated on any street or avenue, then the parking of all vehicles, including private passenger automobiles, buses, delivery sedans, vans and pickup trucks, three-fourths of a ton or under, shall be limited to the lesser parking period so designated.

ARTICLE IV. OPERATION OF VEHICLES*

Sec. 11-93. Operation of trucks and certain nonscheduled buses on certain streets.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any truck, or nonscheduled bus, other than a panel or pickup truck, three-quarters of a ton or under, or a school bus, on any street or avenue in the city designated as "no through trucks or buses," except for the purposes of receiving loads and making deliveries in the case of trucks or for the purpose of letting off or picking up passengers in the case of buses. This section shall be in effect only when signs are erected giving notice of such designation.

Sec. 11-266. Operation and parking prohibited during certain hours; exceptions; erection of signs and markers.

(a) Except as hereinafter provided, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or park a motor vehicle, including mopeds and bicycles with helper motors, or permit such motor vehicle to remain parked between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. of any day on the following highways or portions thereof within the Historic Colonial [Area] and:

- (1) Duke of Gloucester Street between Nassau Street and Blair Street.
- (2) Palace Street between Duke of Gloucester Street and Scotland Street Extended.
- (3) Scotland Street Extended and Scotland Street between Palace Street and North England Street.
- (4) Spotswood Street between Duke of Gloucester Street and Scotland Street Extended.
- (5) Prince George Street between Nassau Street and Palace Street.
- (6) Nicholson Street between Spotswood Street and North England Street.
- (7) Queen Street between Nicholson Street and Francis Street.
- (8) Colonial Street between Nicholson Street and Francis Street.
- (9) Blair Street between Duke of Gloucester Street and Francis Street.
- (10) North England Street between the Scotland Street entrance to the Parkway and Nicholson Street.
- (11) Nicholson Street between North England Street and Waller Street.
- (12) Botetourt Street between Franklin Street and Francis Street; provided, however, that during any scheduled service at Mount Ararat Baptist Church the provisions of this

section shall not apply to that portion of Botetourt Street between Franklin Street and Nicholson Street.

(b) The city manager shall cause appropriate signs, markers or barriers to be provided to designate the portions of the highways of the city which are subject to the provisions of this section.

Sec. 11-268. Same-On certain streets as to operation of buses.

The provisions of section 11-266 shall not apply to the operation of passenger buses on the following portions of highways within the Historic Colonial area:

- (1) Prince George Street between Nassau Street and Palace Street.
- (2) Palace Street between Prince George Street and Scotland Street Extended.
- (3) Scotland Street Extended between Palace Street and North England Street.
- (4) North England Street between the Scotland Street entrance to the Parkway and Nicholson Street.
- (5) Nicholson Street between North England Street and Wailer Street.
